Classroom Helpers

We've recently begun implementing *Classroom Helpers*. I have selected a few age-appropriate jobs that are easy and fun for the kids to accomplish. My goal is to promote a sense of community, responsibility, and a feeling of pride amongst the children. They have been doing magnificently with their jobs, and are very eager to help out!

Every Monday we get together as a group and decide what classroom job each child will be responsible for. All jobs last the duration of the week and are rotated. Jobs may not be repeated until each child has had a turn with each job.

Some of the available jobs are: **Table Monitor** (wiping marker off table with baby wipe), **Book Monitor** (picking up any books lying on the floor and putting them away), **Light Monitor** (turning off lights when we leave the room), **Chair Monitor** (pushing in chairs), **Story Selector** (picking the story for group story time), **Feed Miss Piggy**, etc. When you have a moment, please feel free to look at the Classroom Helpers chart and discuss your child's involvement with their weekly "job" each day.
